The Fall IOU meeting was held in Ankeny on August 22-24. The 108 attendees sure seemed to have a good time. We had twenty first-timers, which could very well be a record. The Metro North Best Western proved to be a fine location for the meeting. The food was great, and "Barb the banquet coordinator" made sure we were well cared for.

The meeting kicked off Friday with check-in and an opportunity to socialize. Larry Stone had a large display of books and his photographs for sale. Thanks to a generous donation of material from Dale Fye, the silent auction table also had a lot for folks to sort through. Field trip sign-up sheets were

available and some of the trip leaders were on hand to talk about the locations and possible species.

After an early breakfast Saturday morning, it was time to go birding. Unfortunately, it was a rough start weather-wise. We were greeted by heavy rain, but most trips took off anyway. By 9:00 the storms had passed and it turned out to be a nice day.

Saylorville and Big Creek

Due to popular demand, it was necessary to have two groups working the reservoirs. Rain and dark skies hampered things early, but conditions improved and so did the birding. Nineteen

shorebirds were tallied, including Black-bellied Plover, American Avocet, Ruddy Turnstone, Sanderling, Stilt Sandpiper and Buff-breasted Sandpiper. It was a good weekend for flycatchers and Olive-sided, Yellow-bellied and Alder were recorded. Other nice finds included Bell's Vireo, Summer Tanager and Orchard Oriole.

Chichaqua Greenbelt

Participants on this trip spent some time paddling around the oxbows near the campground. It sounded like everyone had a great time. Close views of Green Herons, Belted Kingfishers, Red-headed Woodpeckers, and a late Prothonotary Warbler were among the highlights. A calling Pileated Woodpecker was also nearby. Visits to other parts of this large, public area produced Hooded Mergansers, Sora, Sedge Wren, and Marsh Wren.

Waterworks/Ashworth Parks

Mississippi Kite and Acadian Flycatcher were the targets on this trip. Both species cooperated (both mornings) and everyone got great views of each.

Voas/Brenton Slough

This group journeyed into eastern Dallas County. A covey of Northern Bobwhite along the bike trail at Voas was a nice surprise. Other highlights included Sora, Olive-sided Flycatcher, Marsh Wren, and Orchard Oriole.

Neal Smith NWR/Runnells area

This trip visited Neal Smith NWR and the Red Rock Reservoir backwaters near Runnells. Bill Kaempfer is president of the Colorodo Field Ornithologists, the IOU counterpart for that state. He came to our meeting hoping for his lifer Henslow's Sparrow, and he was not disappointed. It was a good breeding season for prairie birds at the refuge and many young were still present. Other sparrows included Vesper and Grasshopper, with many Bobolinks around. The wet conditions hampered the birding around Runnells.

Afternoon sessions

Walt Wagner-Hecht graciously shared a slide show of his trip to Costa Rica this year. Many of you helped support his trip by purchasing birding cards at the Clinton meeting in 2013.

IOU is a proud sponsor of Iowa Young Birders. Carl Bendorf gave us some numbers from this initiative over the last two years:

- 29 field trips with 503 total participants including 267 young birders and 163 parents/grandparents, etc.
- 65% boys and 35% girls
- Average age 10.9 years old

Surveys of field trip participants during 2013 showed:

- IYB trips are attracting birding families who are already quite active (75% have birded away from home in the last month and 90% bird around more than once a week) but for half of the participants, this was their first organized field trip.
- Almost 90% of participants rated their trip experience as very good or excellent.
- 75% of young birders reported a positive change in their awareness of bird diversity in Iowa, the impact of habitat conservation, and awareness of how birds relate to their environments.



The IOU was a sponsor of Iowa/Illinois Young Birder weekend in mid June in which 24 young birders participated in two half-days of field trips along the Mississippi River.

Rich Leopold is Director of the Polk County Conservation Board. In November of 2012,



72% of Polk County voters voted "YES" for the Water and Land Legacy Bond. This gave the go ahead to spend \$50 million over the next 20 years for critical water quality, wildlife, trails, and recreation projects in Polk County. His talk on the background and achievements of this initiative was very informative and entertaining.

IOU member Kevin Murphy's presentation on the impact of sheetwater on waterbird migration was very well received. The Iowa Department of Agriculture's Iowa Initiative is recommending increased use of drainage tiles to combat agricultural runoff pollution. With the loss of over 90% of wetlands



in Iowa's Prairie Pothole Region, it's important to understand how the ephemeral wetlands (sheetwater) are used by waterfowl and shorebirds during migration. As most birders would expect, the study indicated heavy usage by a large number of waterbirds. There were lots of questions from a very engaged audience.

An uneventful general business meeting closed out the session.

After the banquet, John Vanderpoel from Denver, CO, topped off the day with his keynote address. John regaled us with stories of his adventures during his epic 2011 ABA Big Year.

His total of 745 species was the second most ever recorded for an ABA Big Year. (He picked up Gray Partridge and Eurasian Tree Sparrow in Iowa.) John's talk about the planning, challenges, and effort it took for this achievement was thoroughly engrossing. His pictures were spectacular and the rarities he saw were jaw-dropping. It was an amazing presentation.

Sunday field trips

The same field trip options were available on Sunday. The weather challenge for today was hot and windy conditions. Some nice pickups included a Black-crowned Night-Heron at Chichaqua, a wellphotographed Swainson's Hawk at Brenton Slough, Common Tern at Jester, and Yellow-billed Cuckoo at Cherry Glen.

The challenging weather conditions proved to be a mere inconvenience

for the group, as 147 species were tallied. This impressive total wouldn't have been possible without the efforts of our fine field trip leaders. Many thanks to John Bissell, Eric Ollie, John McCecil, Doug Harr, Ray Cummins, Stuart Sparkman, Karen Viste-Sparkman, Mark Proeschoeldt, Dick Stilwell and Sharon Stilwell.

Thanks again to Walt, Carl, Rich and Kevin for their entertaining and informative presentations. Another big "Thank you" to John for traveling from Colorado to share his Big Year adventures. Thanks again to John McCecil for setting up the Silent Auction. \$357 was raised for the Publications Fund. The attendees went above and beyond in supporting this effort. Larry Stone also expressed thanks for the support he received at the meeting.

Finally, thanks to all the attendees for making this such a fun meeting. I hope to see you all in Algona next May.

Iowa 2013 Listing and Big Day Totals

Thirty-six IOU members submitted life list totals through the end of 2013. Tom Stone Sr. added two accidentals to his list, Ross's Gull and Sharp-tailed Sandpiper, to raise his total to 391, two notches above Jim Fuller. We do not know if Tom took Aaron Brees and Jim Forde out for dinner. Steve Dinsmore continues to top the Personally Found list, followed by Jim Fuller, Ray Cummins and Lee Schoenewe, all at or above 320.

2013 Annual Lists - Only one birder, Tommy Stone, broke the 300 mark for species in 2013, although Steve Dinsmore was close behind. In doing so, Tommy encountered 86% of the birds on his life list, highest among veteran, active birders. Keith Dyche had 80%, and John Bissell had 77%.

These included first county records for Audubon, Davis, Howard and Jones, bringing to 34 the number of counties with Big Day records. Paul Roisen participated in three of these new County Big Days along with Tom Schilke (Howard Co.), Keith Dyche (Audubon Co.), and Tommy Stone (Davis Co.). Roisen and Schilke also raised the Mitchell County Big Day mark to 107. Chris Edwards and Bill Scheible established an initial mark of 114 for Jones County.

The single statewide Big Day reported was huge, the first total over 180 in many years. Steve Dinsmore, Paul Skrade and Kevin Murphy tallied 181 species on a route through central Iowa. This kind of total is only possible in a brief window in May, when most breeders have returned, and late waterfowl migrants and lingering winter visitors can be found alongside transient shorebirds and neotropic migrants. The team had late Goldeneye, Common and Red-breasted Mergansers, Purple Finches and Pine Siskins along with 24 species of shorebirds and 20 species of warblers. A couple of bonuses were Neotropic Cormorant and White-faced Ibis.
